



Our Energy Conservation & Carbon Policy articulates our commitment to actively contribute towards these efforts and take responsible action for prudent and efficient use of energy sources to achieve continual improvement in our energy performance and reduction in our carbon footprint. To achieve this we stand committed to :

- Meet legal compliance and other requirements related to energy and carbon across all our operating units.
- Carry out our operations based on the principles of :
 - a) Refuse : Endeavour to completely eliminate energy or resource usage wherever feasible.
 - b) Reduce : Try to reduce the quantum of energy or resources used.
 - e) Re-use : Attempt to re-use or recover for further use any energy or resources as far as practicable.
- Explore and utilize renewable energy, waste heat and clean fuel wherever techno-economically feasible across our operations.
- Give priority to investment in clean energy, both in terms of our own usage / consumption as well as in terms of our product portfolio.
- Support design activities and establish engineering controls that consider energy and carbon performance improvement.
- Adopt economically viable new / efficient clean technologies and best practices for improving energy efficiency and carbon performance.
- Support procurement of energy efficient products / services and suppliers / vendors that positively impact energy and carbon performance.
- Create and raise awareness about the responsible use of energy resources across our operations and stakeholders, to encourage them towards efficient utilization of such resources with a focus on reducing the energy and carbon intensity of our operations.
- Work in partnership with regulatory authorities, expert bodies, relevant suppliers, contractors and all stakeholders as applicable, to understand and initiate improvement projects.
